## SAT School Day Parental Exception Waiver

## Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your teen will have the opportunity to take the SAT college entrance examination during the regular school day. The SAT, which is accepted at some U.S. colleges, measures what students are learning in high school and what they need to know to succeed in college and career. Even at "test-blind" universities that no longer require the SAT (University of California and California State University systems), test scores may be used for course placement or merit scholarships. Taking the SAT exam during the school day can increase students' access to college, address barriers that hinder students from taking the exam, and reduce testing stress, e.g., eliminating financial hardship in paying for the exam, taking the test in a more familiar environment.

Van Nuys High School's SAT School Day administration, which is at no cost to students in the Class of 2022 is scheduled on October 13, 2021. However, you as a parent have the right to request that your teen not participate in this test administration by completing the form below and submitting it to the SAT School Day Coordinator/College Counselor, Ms. Charlton.
