


### Complete the School Experience Survey by February 5

Los Angeles Unified's School Experience Survey launched on Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup>, for students, parents and staff, with a questionnaire that provides important feedback about the teaching and learning environment on their campus, including their distance-learning experience.

The survey window has been extended until January 22, and there are separate online questionnaires for parents and school-based staff and for students in Grades 4-12. The surveys can be completed on any digital device, including the computers provided by Los Angeles Unified to students and families.
