**NOTE TO PARENTS/ IMPORTANT DATES TO RESERVE A SPACE FOR SUMMER SCHOOL**

- A. Hand deliver ORIGINAL referral/application to your desired school site location during office hours (M-F, 8:00 am-12:00 pm & 1:00 pm-5:00 pm).
- B. Once our regular school sites are filled, referrals will be accommodated at our annex site.
- C. SFV Centers will be closed on the following dates: 2/13, 2/20, 3/20, 3/21, 3/31, 5/29.
- D. Centers will have limited availability during state test administration from 4/17/17 – 5/5/17. Referrals can be dropped off between 3:00 -5:00 pm on these days.
- E. Orientation will happen in May and June. Both students and parents must attend to sign paperwork and receive curriculum. Because of the volume of students we serve, students who are late or who miss orientation will forfeit their spot.
- F. Summer School is from July 3<sup>rd</sup> – August 4<sup>th</sup>. Students cannot miss appointments or take vacation during this time. However, once their classes are completed, students are done. (Ex: Students who finish a class in 2 weeks will not attend the remaining 3 weeks of summer school.)
- G. Transcripts will be hand-delivered to school counselors at the start of the fall semester.
